



Registered Pharmacy Technician Training Program - Checklist:



- I have submitted the Application for Registered Pharmacy Technician Training Programs.
- I have submitted the following documentation as a Non-Employer-Based Program:
 - Evidence of licensure by the Florida Commission for Independent Education or equivalent licensing authority of another state or be within the public-school system of the State of Florida,
 - Sample Transcript and Sample Diploma,
 - Copy of curriculum, catalog or other course descriptions, and
 - Copy of Faculty Credentials (job description, resume or curriculum vitae).

OR

- I have submitted the following documentation as an Employer-Based Program:
 - Copy of Faculty Credentials (job description, resume or curriculum vitae),
 - Copy of curriculum, catalog or other course descriptions,
 - Sample evaluation to be filled out by participants at completion of program, and
 - Copy of an individual Certificate of Completion for the program.

Before you submit...

- **Verify** your email address on the application. If you answered “YES” to “I want to be notified by email,” the Board office will communicate via email first.
- **Check** your application to ensure it is complete; answer all questions on the application truthfully and to the best of your ability.
- Pursuant to the provisions set forth in Rule 64B16-26.351, FAC, the following programs are approved Registered Pharmacy Technician Training Programs and do not require application to the Board of Pharmacy:
 - Pharmacy technician training programs accredited by a regional or national accrediting agency; a regional or national institutional accrediting agency; or a specialized accrediting agency recognized by the Secretary of the United States Department of Education;
 - Pharmacy technician training programs accredited on or before December 1, 2018 by the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists (ASHP);
 - Pharmacy technician training programs at institutions accredited on or before December 1, 2018 by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS);
 - Pharmacy technician training programs approved on or before December 1, 2018 by the Florida Commission for Independent Education (CIE);
 - Pharmacy technician training programs provided by a branch of the federal armed services on or before December 1, 2018;
 - Pharmacy technician training programs at institutions accredited on or before December 1, 2018 by the Council on Occupational Education (COE).
